CERAMICS AND PAINTING

WEEK 1 (JUNE 3-6)-Ceramics: Students will develop the art of pottery making through the use of the elements and principles of design; the elements being line, shape, space, color, texture and pattern and the principles being balance, unity, rhythm, proportion, color interaction and figure/ground relationships. Students will have the opportunity to utilize slab, coil building, hand building, glazing, molding, decorating, throwing on the potter's wheel and firing techniques.

STUDENTS HAVE THE CHOICE TO PAINT FOR 2 WEEKS IF THEY DO NOT WANT TO WORK IN CLAY.

WEEK 2 (JUNE 17-20)-Painting: Students will develop painting techniques through the use of the elements and principles of design. Students will study color, shading, perspective, value, line, concept and composition.

Classes will be held in the Toolen building in the Art room (7110).

ALL SUPPLIES ARE PROVIDED along with a snack each day.
